2. Collection of 5 veg – 2 of each, on a tray
3. Collection of berries
4. Funniest-looking vegetable or fruit

5. Vase of mixed garden flowers
6. 3 flowering herbaceous perennials
7. 3 flowering shrubs
8. Vase of Dahlias
9. Vase of Sweet Peas
10. Vase of Roses



Flower/Grass Arrangements

11. Wildflowers in a jam jar (or attractive weeds from your garden/allotment)
12. Arrangement in an unusual container
13. Miniature fairy garden in a seed tray



Cookery

14. Creative Tray of Tea for Two – a tray showing appropriate crockery/flowers with two different food items.
15. Creative Picnic basket showing sweet & savoury items. Could be themed e.g. wartime, Valentines Day.
16. Jar of jam or marmalade
17. Jar of chutney
